## MEETINGS BY THE MINUTE

December 5, 2012

President Tom Grace called the meeting to order at 7:09pm. There were 30 members and one guest present. Curtis Welch made a motion to elect the officers that had been nominated at the previous meeting. Jeff Vermillion seconded the motion and it carried in a voice vote. Officers for 2013 will be as follows: Tom Grace President, Jack Chaney Vice President, Steve Ehrman Secretary, Jon Webb Treasurer, and Justin Stromberg continues as Tournament director. Tom reminded the membership of the Wright McGill discount offer good through the end of the year. The Rapala purchase offer is very close to being completed, any remaining orders should be immediately directed to Tom Grace. George Mauries is planning the annual awards Banquet and has secured Piccolos Restaurant near Hampden and Monaco as the location. The date is proposed for Jan 26, 2013 but has not been finalized.

The State Federation is considering changing the STQT format and the Bell, Jones and Conway proposals were offered. The Bell proposal drops the number of STQT qualifiers from 12 plus an alternate to 10 plus an alternate and adds a "Last Chance" 2 day tournament to be held in Colorado or in close proximity to Colorado. Positions 11 and 12, both non boater positions, would be filled by the top two eligible fishermen competing in the "Last Chance" tournament. Federation members could fish the "Last Chance" on a "Money only" basis but will be required to declare their status prior to fishing. All qualifiers from the STQT will retain their team standing. Only positions 11 and 12 will

be open. The STQT alternate will remain as the alternate and if additional alternates are needed they will be selected as they placed in STQT. The membership discussed the Jones proposal and Conway proposal and thought both involved too many tournaments and too much expense to make them feasible. Jack Chaney, the club's STQT representative, was directed to present the Bell proposal to the STQT committee as DBM's preferred format and to leave the format as is as DBM's second choice, several lakes were suggested for the STQT and Jack will offer DBM's lake preferences to the STQT committee. Brandon Genova is updating the roster and asked the membership to email corrections, additions or deletions to him at Brandon@brandongenova.com. The Hot Dog and Brat Fund raiser has been finalized for December 8th and 9th with projected sales being reduced due to inclement weather forecasts. The club thanks Pat Gillen for his fund raiser donation of propane. Ken Beiner was welcomed as a new member. Justin Stromberg was chosen as Member of the Year, other nominees were Curtis Welch and Tom Grace. Tournament lakes and approximate dates for the 2013 season were selected and are as follows: April Norton, May Boyd, June Lonetree, July Pueblo, August Horsetooth, September Pueblo. The meeting adjourned at 9:12pm
